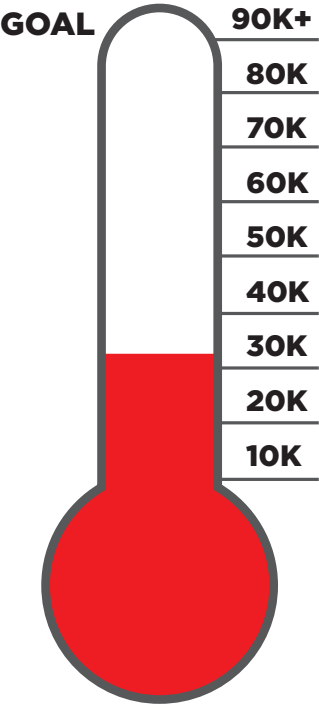
TAX FREE IRA CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE PARK

Must be 70 1/2 or older to be eligible. Simply instruct your trustee to make the distribution from your IRA to the park. The distribution would otherwise be taxable. This will count towards satisfying any required minimum distribution. These gifts are known as “charitable IRA Rollovers.” As always seek the help of a professional planner or funds advisor. All items ordered from out order from must be placed directly with the Park Association. Any items donated to the Park are subject to board approval. The board reserves the right to accept or reject any donated item. Bench orders are a long process and we try to ensure the benches are ready before one of our dedication ceremonies.

Due to increased granite costs, effective January 1, 2020 bench prices will increase. Benches without backs will sell for \$2,500. Benches with backs will sell for \$3,000.
